






















SOME IMPORTANT INFORMATION

OUR PHILOSOPHY

Play is at the heart of childhood and simply the most important thing we offer children. Through play, children learn to respectfully engage with the world and people around them.

In the natural environment children grow and develop through messy play, exploration and curiosity. This provides opportunities for children to develop risk taking, resiliance, friendship, self worth and a sence of social conscience. We create an inclusive environment where every individual can feel safe, valued and happy

ADVENTUROUS PLAY

Alongside our Educational programs, here at Adventure Patch we encourage and promote adventurous play in our services. Our Educators are equipped with the knowledge and skill set to encourage children to take risks and be courageous all while providing a safe environment for all in our care.

Children are faced with risks every day. Rather than trying to eliminate all risks from children's play, our services will identify the possible risks and make informed decisions about whether the benefit for children's development and learning outweighs the risks in any situation. We will ensure that every reasonable precaution is taken to protect children from harm and from any hazard likely to cause injury.

Our Educators will never force children to take a risk they feel uncomfortable to take. Our Job is to positively encourage and guide children to negotiate the risk on their own, to assess and make their own choice as to their own limitations.

RISK ASSESSMENTS

Risk assessments have been completed where required; if you wish to see a risk assessment, please speak to a member of the team.

PARTICIPATION

By booking your child into a day, you agree for your child to participate in the day's activities. If you wish for your child to not participate in an activity listed, please speak to a member of the team and we will endeavor to provide alternative activities for your children to participate in.

However, please note that during our excursion days all children are required to attend with the entirety of the group as we are unable to split the day with a group on an excursion and a group remaining at the service.

Today's item may be taken home by your child. Please see a member of the team at collection time so you don't forget to collect your children's creation.




MAXIMUM CAPACITY




